



## 2009 Backyard Harvest Booth Program

*Sequim residents and Open Aire Market patrons are asking for more produce and farm products.*

*The Peninsula abounds with small growers, backyard farmers and community gardeners who grow more produce than they can eat.*

In recognition of these two factors, the Open Aire Market has developed a new program for 2009: The Backyard Harvest Booth Program.

Any week of the Market season that one or more small-scale growers would like to attend and sell produce, the Open Aire Market will set up a “Backyard Harvest Booth” and provide a table for produce sales.

In order to sell produce at the table, the grower must:

- Become a part-time Open Aire Market member at \$25
- Pay booth rent at standard Market rate for each day (up to three) attended: \$10 for sales up to \$100; \$15 for sales \$101 - \$250; \$20 for sales \$251 - \$500
- Report daily sales to Site Manager
- Abide by all Open Aire Market rules
- Schedule attendance in advance with the Site Manager

If you are a vegetable grower of any size who would like to try your hand at Market sales, this program is for you! If you have corn for two Saturdays in the fall, raspberries coming out your ears, a field of garlic in need of good homes, or a full garden’s bountiful harvest in autumn then consider the Open Aire Market Backyard Harvest Booth Program.
