

Options for presenting musician information on the Sequim Open Aire Market Website:

Note: Musicians will be listed on the SOAM website Calendar Page on the dates scheduled for appearance. That listing, which will include a very concise description of musical style, will be linked to an individual web page if there is one.

Minimal presence: Your (or your group) name listed on a drop-down menu on our musician page with nothing further and no link.

Website Link: Your (or your group) name listed on a drop-down menu on our musician page that links to your website (presented in a new window).

Link to individual musician page on our website: Your (or your group) name listed on a drop-down menu on our musician page that links to a dedicated page on our website (presented in a new window) that should include:

1. Your (or your group) name and demographics
  - a. Name (or group name)
  - b. Address (unless you don't want it to appear)
  - c. Telephone Number
  - d. Contact Name
  - e. Email address
  - f. Website link
  - g. Entertainer at the Open Aire Market since (year).
  - h. Concise (up to 8 words) Description of primary musical style, i.e., "Classical Guitar".
2. Description (can be almost anything you wish to convey) of not more than 300 words. The dates of scheduled appearances at the market will be listed here, as well as on the Calendar Page.
3. Four or fewer pictures that will be presented with a maximum of width of 295 pixels (larger pictures can be submitted and will be formatted to fit the space) and should be accompanied by concise captions.

Preformatted web pages cannot/will not be used.

  - photos should be sent as attachments to an email
